





GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF T20 BLOG POSTS

We welcome insightful contributions related to <u>South Africa's G20 presidency</u> or <u>T20 South Africa themes</u>. Please adhere to the following guidelines for your submission:

Content and Theme:

- Your submission **must** directly relate to the themes of South Africa's G20 presidency *or* one of the five task forces of the T20.
- Please clearly indicate the specific theme(s) your submission addresses.
- Submissions should be no longer than 800 words.
- To ensure accessibility, please avoid footnotes and academic referencing.
 Instead, use in-text hyperlinks to relevant sources.
- Where your recommendations relate to the agenda of a specific working group or task force under the South African G20 presidency, please indicate this.

Authorship and Format:

- Submissions can be co-authored.
- Please provide the following author information at the end of your submission:
 - o Full Name
 - Institutional Affiliation
 - Institution's Country
 - Example: Dr. Philani Mthembu, Executive Director, Institute for Global Dialogue associated with UNISA (South Africa).
- If available, please include a link to your LinkedIn and/or X (formerly Twitter) profile.
- Your submission must be in MS Word format.









Submission Process:

- Send your submission to <u>t20@t20southafrica.org</u>.
- Use the subject line: "T20 blog submission".
- Submissions will be reviewed by the relevant task forces.
- The end date for the submission of blogs will be 31 October 2025.

Due to the anticipated volume of submissions, only successful candidates will be contacted.

If you do not receive a response within 10 days, please consider your submission unsuccessful.
